ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE ON
PETITION FOR RECIPROCAL DISCIPLINE

Pursuant to Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure (“TRDP”) Part IX, the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas filed a Petition for Reciprocal Discipline against Respondent T. Anthony Guajardo on February 22, 2017. The Petition states that on or about February 2, 2017, a Judgment of Disbarment was entered before the Presiding Disciplinary Judge of the Supreme Court of Arizona in a matter styled *In the Matter of a Suspended Member of the state Bar of Arizona, T. Anthony Guajardo, Bar No. 021500, Respondent*, PDJ 2016-9126. Respondent filed his Consent to Disbarment on January 31, 2017. A true and correct copy of the Petition for Reciprocal Discipline with the Judgment of Disbarment is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as if set forth in full.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** that T. Anthony Guajardo, Respondent, shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order to Show Cause and Petition for Reciprocal Discipline, show cause why the imposition by the Board of Disciplinary Appeals of identical discipline in Texas pursuant to TRDP § 9.02 would be unwarranted.

It is further **ORDERED** that this matter is set for hearing before the Board on Friday, April 28, 2017 at 9 a.m. in the courtroom of the Supreme Court of Texas, Austin, Texas.
