ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE ON THIRD AMENDED PETITION FOR RECIPROCAL DISCIPLINE AND HEARING NOTICE

Pursuant to Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure ("TRDP") Part IX, the Commission for Lawyer Discipline, Petitioner, filed a Third Amended Petition for Reciprocal Discipline against Respondent Al Fadel Amer on June 9, 2021. The Petition states that on or about June 23, 2017, the Supreme Court of California, en banc, entered an Order in the matter styled *In re Al Fadel Amer on Discipline*, State Bar Court Case Nos. 15-O-13372 and 15-O-13972, disbarring Respondent. A true and correct copy of the Third Amended Petition for Reciprocal Discipline, including the Order, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as if set forth in full.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** that, Respondent Al Fadel Amer shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order to Show Cause and Third Amended Petition for Reciprocal Discipline, show cause why the imposition of identical discipline, to the extent practicable, in Texas by the Board of Disciplinary Appeals pursuant to Texas Rule of Disciplinary Procedure 9.02 would be unwarranted.
