AGREED ORDER OF INDEFINITE DISABILITY SUSPENSION

The Chief Disciplinary Counsel (hereinafter referred to as “CDC”), reasonably believes that Kellye Sorelle (hereinafter referred to as “Respondent”) is suffering from a Disability and has been authorized by the Commission for Lawyer Discipline to enter into this Agreed Indefinite Order of Disability Suspension.

Any pending disciplinary cases are hereby abated for the duration of the suspension pursuant to Rule 12.05 of the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent Kellye Sorelle is indefinitely suspended from the practice of law.

It is further **ORDERED** that Respondent Kellye Sorelle, during said suspension, is hereby enjoined from practicing law in Texas, holding herself out as an attorney at law, performing any legal services, appearing as counsel in any representative capacity in any proceeding in any Texas court or before any Texas administrative body, or holding herself out to others or using her name, in any manner, in conjunction with the words “attorney at law”, “counselor at law”, or “lawyer.”

It is further **ORDERED** Respondent Kellye Sorelle within thirty (30) days from the date of this Judgment, shall notify in writing each and every justice of the peace, judge, magistrate, and chief justice of each and every court in which Respondent has any legal matter pending, if any, of this suspension, of the style and cause number of the pending matter(s) and of the name,

address, and telephone number of the client(s) Respondent is representing in that court.

It is further **ORDERED** that Respondent Kellye Sorelle shall immediately notify each of her current clients, if any, in writing, of this suspension. In addition to such notification, Respondent is **ORDERED** to return all files, papers, unearned fees paid in advance, and all other monies and properties which are in her possession but which belong to current or former clients, if any, to those respective clients or former clients within thirty (30) days after the date on which this Judgment is signed by the Board.

Respondent is further **ORDERED** to file with this Board, within the same thirty (30) days, an affidavit stating that all current clients have been notified of her suspension and that all files, papers, unearned fees paid in advance, and all other monies and properties belonging to clients and former clients have been returned as ordered herein. If Respondent should be unable to return any file, papers, money or other property to any client or former client, Respondent's affidavit shall state with particularity the efforts made by Respondent with respect to each particular client and the cause of his inability to return to said client any file, paper, money or other property.

Respondent is also **ORDERED** to mail a copy of said affidavit and copies of all notification letters to clients to the Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel, State Bar of Texas, P.O. Box 12487, Austin, TX 78711-2487 (1414 Colorado St., Austin, TX 78701).

It is also **ORDERED** that Respondent Kellye Sorelle shall immediately surrender her Texas law license and permanent State Bar Card to the Regional Counsel of the State Bar of




