ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

On this day, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the Unopposed Motion for Continuance filed by Richard Everett Biggs, Respondent, in the above-captioned reciprocal discipline case. Respondent requests that the hearing on the petition for reciprocal discipline be reset to a later date to allow the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit to decide a pending appeal involving the underlying order that gives rise to this reciprocal discipline case. Petitioner, the Commission for Lawyer Discipline, is unopposed to the relief sought by Respondent.

The Board **ORDERS** that Respondent’s Unopposed Motion for Continuance is **GRANTED**, and the hearing on the petition for reciprocal discipline set for Friday, July 31, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. is removed from the docket.

Any other relief not expressly granted in this order is denied.
