**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE ON
PETITION FOR RECIPROCAL DISCIPLINE**

Pursuant to Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure ("TRDP") Part IX, the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas filed a Petition for Reciprocal Discipline against Respondent Charles Marvin Bradshaw, II on February 22, 2017. The Petition states that on or about March 24, 2017, the Supreme Court of Louisiana entered its Order per curiam publicly reprimanding Respondent in a matter styled *In re: Charles Marvin Bradshaw, II, Attorney Disciplinary Proceeding*, No. 2016-B-0356 (Louisiana Bar Roll number 26610). Respondent had consented to the discipline. A true and correct copy of the Petition for Reciprocal Discipline with the Order is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as if set forth in full.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** that Charles Marvin Bradshaw, II, Respondent, shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order to Show Cause and Petition for Reciprocal Discipline, show cause why the imposition by the Board of Disciplinary Appeals of identical discipline in Texas pursuant to TRDP § 9.02 would be unwarranted.

It is further **ORDERED** that this matter is set for hearing before the Board on Friday, April 28, 2017 at 9 a.m. in the courtroom of the Supreme Court of Texas, Austin, Texas.
