**JUDGMENT AFFIRMING EVIDENTIARY JUDGMENT
OF PARTIALLY PROBATED SUSPENSION**

On April 29, 2016, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals heard argument on the merits in Appellant John Hatchett Carney's appeal from a Judgment of Partially Probated Suspension signed May 21, 2015, by the Evidentiary Panel 6-1 of the District 6 Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas in SBOT Cause D0091144006. Appellant appeared in person and through his attorney, Charles W. McGarry, and the Commission for Lawyer Discipline of the State Bar of Texas appeared through Assistant Disciplinary Counsel with the Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel.

After considering the record and the briefs of the parties and hearing argument, the Board finds that the Judgment of Partially Probated Suspension should be, in all respects, affirmed.
