AGREED JUDGMENT OF PUBLIC REPRIMAND

On the <u>22</u> day of <u>4</u> day of <u>4</u> 2018, the above-styled and numbered reciprocal disciplinary action was called for hearing before the Board of Disciplinary Appeals. Petitioner appeared by attorney and Respondent appeared in person as indicated by their respective signatures below and announced that they agree to the findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders set forth below. The Board of Disciplinary Appeals, having reviewed the file and in consideration of the agreement of the parties, is of the opinion that Petitioner is entitled to entry of the following findings and orders:

Findings of Fact. The Board of Disciplinary Appeals finds that:

- (1) Respondent, Paul Anthony Carthew whose State Bar Card number is 00796315, is licensed by the Supreme Court of Texas to practice law, but is not currently authorized to practice law in the State of Texas;
- (2) On or about November 9, 2012, a Formal Complaint was entered by the State of Michigan Attorney Disciplinary Board in a matter styled: Grievance Administrator, Michigan Attorney Grievance Commission, Petitioner v. Paul A. Carthew, P60940, Respondent, Case No. 12-122-GA.
- (3) On or about November 9, 2012, a Stipulation for Consent Order of Reprimand was entered by the State of Michigan Attorney Disciplinary Board in a matter styled: Grievance Administrator, Michigan Attorney Grievance Commission, Petitioner v. Paul A. Carthew, P60940, Respondent.

- (4) On or about November 9, 2012, a Waiver was entered by the State of Michigan Attorney Disciplinary Board in a matter styled: Grievance Administrator, Michigan Attorney Grievance Commission, Petitioner v. Paul A. Carthew, P60940, Respondent, Case No. 12-122-GA.
- (5) On or about December 7, 2012, the Report of Tri-County Hearing Panel #59 was entered by the State of Michigan Attorney Disciplinary Board in a matter styled: Grievance Administrator, Michigan Attorney Grievance Commission, Petitioner v. Paul A. Carthew, P60940, Respondent, Case No. 12-122-GA.
- (6) On or about December 7, 2012, an Order of Reprimand was entered by the State of Michigan Attorney Disciplinary Board in a matter styled: Grievance Administrator, Michigan Attorney Grievance Commission, Petitioner v. Paul A. Carthew, P60940, Respondent, Case No. 12-122-GA, which states in pertinent part as follows:
 - ... IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent, Paul A. Carthew, is hereby REPRIMANDED...
- (7) In the Report of the Tri-County Hearing Panel #59, the Panel concluded that Respondent's plea of no contest to the charges of misconduct in the formal complaint was entered knowingly and voluntarily and the plea of no contest was accepted. Accordingly, the panel found that Respondent violated an order of discipline, in violation of MCR 9.104(9); held himself out as an attorney while suspended, in violation of MCR 9.119(E)(4); engaged in conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice, in violation of MCR 9.104(1) and MRPC 8.4(c); engaged in conduct that exposes the legal profession to obloquy, contempt, censure, or reproach, in violation of MCR 9.104(2); engaged in conduct that is contrary to justice, ethics, honesty, or good morals, in violation of MCR 9.104(3); and violated the standards or rules of professional responsibility adopted by the Supreme Court, in violation of MCR 9.104(4).
- (8) Respondent, Paul Anthony Carthew, is the same person as the Paul A. Carthew, who is the subject of the Order of Reprimand entered by the State of Michigan Attorney Disciplinary Board; and
- (9) The Order of Reprimand entered by the State of Michigan Attorney Disciplinary Board is final.

Conclusions of Law. Based upon the foregoing findings of facts the Board of Disciplinary

Appeals makes the following conclusions of law:

- (1) This Board has jurisdiction to hear and determine this matter. Rule 7.08(H), Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure;
- (2) Reciprocal discipline identical to that imposed by the State of Michigan Attorney Disciplinary Board is warranted in this case.

It is, accordingly, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Respondent, Paul Anthony Carthew, State Bar Card No. 00796315, is hereby PUBLICLY REPRIMANDED as an attorney at law in the State of Texas.
