**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

Pursuant to Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure (“TRDP”) Part IX, the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas filed a Petition for Reciprocal Discipline against Respondent Dean Gregory Chandler, Bar Card No. 24071146, on March 18, 2014. The Petition states that on or about September 11, 2013, the Supreme Court of California disbarred Respondent by Order in Cause No. S211687, styled *In re Dean Gregory Chandler on Discipline*. A true and correct copy of the Petition for Reciprocal Discipline and Order are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as if set forth in full.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** that Dean Gregory Chandler, Respondent, shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order to Show Cause and Petition for Reciprocal Discipline, show cause why the imposition by the Board of Disciplinary Appeals of identical discipline in Texas pursuant to TRDP § 9.02 would be unwarranted.

It is further **ORDERED** that this matter is set for hearing before the Board on Friday, May 2, 2014, at 9 a.m. in the courtroom of the Supreme Court of Texas, Austin, Texas.
