## JUDGMENT AFFIRMING JUDGMENT OF ACTIVE SUSPENSION

On April 26, 2013 the Board of Disciplinary Appeals heard the appeal by Respondent below Cyril O. Chukwurah, Texas Bar Card No. 24048394, from the Judgment of Active Suspension (SBOT Case No. H0041132816) signed June 25, 2012 by the 4D Evidentiary Panel of the District 4 Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas. Appellee Commission for Lawyer Discipline of the State Bar of Texas was represented by the Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel. Having considered the record and briefs of the parties and having heard oral argument, the Board determines that:

- The record supports a finding and conclusion that Chukwurah violated Texas
   Disciplinary Rule of Professional Conduct ("TDRPC") 1.14(a) as a matter of law, and
   the Board AFFIRMS that finding and conclusion.
- 2. There is substantial evidence to support the finding and conclusion that Chukwurah violated TDRPC 1.14(b), and the Board AFFIRMS that finding and conclusion.

## THEREFORE, the Board AFFIRMS the Judgment of Active Suspension (SBOT Case

No. H0041132816) signed June 25, 2012 in all respects.
