ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Appellant Michael L. Davis filed a notice of appeal on March 2, 2022. The clerk of the District 3 Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas filed the clerk's record on June 1, 2022. In accordance with BODA's Internal Procedural Rule 4.03(a), the reporter's record was also due to be filed on June 1, 2022.

On June 8, 2022, the Board sent Appellant a letter stating that the reporter's record was late and requested that Appellant that the reporter's record be filed within thirty (30) days. The letter notified Appellant that failure to file the reporter's record on time may result in the Board dismissing the appeal.

Having received no reporter's record and no request for an extension of time to file the reporter's record, the Board **ORDERS** that Appellant Michael L. Davis, within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of this order, **RESPOND AND SHOW CAUSE** why the appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. *See* BODA Internal Procedural Rule 4.03(a), 4.09.
