**FIRST AMENDED ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE  
ON PETITION FOR RECIPROCAL DISCIPLINE  
AND HEARING NOTICE**

Pursuant to Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure (“TRDP”) Part IX, the Commission for Lawyer Discipline, Petitioner, filed a Petition for Reciprocal Discipline against Respondent Carl B. Duke, Jr. on September 8, 2021. The Petition states that on or about February 17, 2021, the Supreme Court of the State of Louisiana entered an order in the matter styled *In re: Carl Binus Duke, Jr.*, Case No. 2020-B-1272. That order reflects that Respondent’s license to practice law in the State of Louisiana was suspended for two years, with all but one year and one day deferred. A true and correct copy of the First Amended Petition for Reciprocal Discipline, which includes that order, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as if set forth in full.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** that Respondent Carl B. Duke, Jr. shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this First Amended Order to Show Cause on Petition for Reciprocal Discipline, show cause why the imposition of identical discipline, to the extent practicable, in Texas by the Board of Disciplinary Appeals pursuant to Texas Rule of Disciplinary Procedure 9.02, would be unwarranted.

It is further **ORDERED** that this matter is set for hearing before the Board on Friday, October 29, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. by remote appearance, <https://txcourts.zoom.us/j/95968888269>, Zoom meeting ID: 959 6888 8269.
