AGREED JUDGMENT OF PUBLIC REPRIMAND

2011, the above-styled and numbered reciprocal disciplinary action was called for hearing before the Board of Disciplinary Appeals. Petitioner appeared by attorney and Respondent appeared in person as indicated by their respective signatures below and announced that they agree to the findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders set forth below. The Board of Disciplinary Appeals, having reviewed the file and in consideration of the agreement of the parties, is of the opinion that Petitioner is entitled to entry of the following findings and orders:

Findings of Fact. The Board of Disciplinary Appeals finds that:

- (1) Respondent, David Duane Dusek, whose State Bar Card number is 00792478, is licensed by the Supreme Court of Texas to practice law but is not currently authorized to practice law in the State of Texas;
- (2) On September 13, 2010, a Stipulation, Consent to Discipline and Order of Reprimand by the Hearing Panel was entered by the Disciplinary Board of the Supreme Court of North Dakota in a matter styled: File No. 4913-NE-0905. In the Matter of the Application for Disciplinary Action Against David D. Dusek, a Member of the Bar of the State of North Dakota, Disciplinary Board of the Supreme Court of the State of North Dakota, Petitioner, v. David D. Dusek, Respondent, publically reprimanding Respondent.
- (3)Respondent, David Duane Dusek, is the same person as the David D. Dusek, who is the subject of the Stipulation, Consent to Discipline and Order of Reprimand by the Hearing Panel was entered by the Disciplinary Board of the Supreme Court of North Dakota; and

(4) The Stipulation, Consent to Discipline and Order of Reprimand by the Hearing Panel entered by the Disciplinary Board of the Supreme Court of North Dakota is final.

Conclusions of Law. Based upon the foregoing findings of facts the Board of Disciplinary

Appeals makes the following conclusions of law:

- (1) This Board has jurisdiction to hear and determine this matter. Rule 7.08(H), Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure;
- (2) Reciprocal discipline identical to that imposed by the Disciplinary Board of the Supreme Court of North Dakota is warranted in this case.

It is, accordingly, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Respondent, David Duane Dusek, State Bar Card No. 00792478, is hereby PUBLICLY REPRIMANDED as an attorney at law in the State of Texas,
