ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION

On this day came on to be heard the Board of Disciplinary Appeals' own motion to dismiss the above appeal filed by Appellant, Connie Gourdan, in State Bar of Texas cause number D3110322612, BODA Cause No. 36173 for want of prosecution.

After reviewing the papers filed in the matter, the Board finds that the Appellant filed her appeal on September 28, 2005. The clerk's record and the reporter's record (if any) were due to be filed on or before October 26, 2005. The CDC filed the clerk's record with the Board on October 27, 2005. There was no reporter's record in this matter. The Appellant's brief was originally due on or before November 25, 2005. The Appellant's brief has not been filed, and Appellant has not requested an extension of time to file her brief.

An Order Show Cause was issued on January 10, 2006 giving the Appellant thirty (30) days to show cause why the appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. The Appellant did not respond.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this appeal is hereby **DISMISSED** for want of prosecution with prejudice to refile.
