JUDGMENT AFFIRMING EVIDENTIARY JUDGMENT OF DISBARMENT

On October 23, 2014, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals heard argument on the merits in Appellant Elene B. Glassman’s appeal from a Judgment of Disbarment signed June 18, 2013, by the Evidentiary Panel 4-6 of the District 4 Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas. Appellant appeared in person pro se, and the Commission for Lawyer Discipline of the State Bar of Texas appeared through the Senior Appellate Counsel with the Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel.
