ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Pursuant to Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure ("TRDP") Part IX, the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas filed a Petition for Reciprocal Discipline against Respondent Alan Edward Gooding, Bar Card No. 24028488, on November 19, 2013. The Petition states that on or about November 14, 2012, the Presiding Disciplinary Judge of the Supreme Court of Arizona signed a Final Judgment and Order suspending Respondent from the practice of law for three (3) years, effective immediately, in the matter styled *In the Matter of a Suspended Member of the State Bar of Arizona, Alan E. Gooding, Bar No. 023060*, No. PDJ-2012-9070. A true and correct copy of the Petition for Reciprocal Discipline and Final Judgment and Order are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as if set forth in full.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** that Alan Edward Gooding, Respondent, shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order to Show Cause and Petition for Reciprocal Discipline, show cause why the imposition by the Board of Disciplinary Appeals of identical discipline in Texas pursuant to TRDP § 9.02 would be unwarranted.

It is further **ORDERED** that this matter is set for hearing before the Board on Friday, January 31, 2014, at 9 a.m. in the courtroom of the Supreme Court of Texas, Austin, Texas.
