**INTRODUCTION**

1. Petitioner is the Commission for Lawyer Discipline, a committee of the State Bar of Texas. Respondent is John O'neill Green, State Bar No. 00785927.
2. Petitioner filed its Petition for Compulsory Discipline on September 8, 2021, asking this Board to disbar Respondent based on his conviction for Count 1 of the Indictment, filed July 18, 2018, Conspiracy to Defraud the United States in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 371. Respondent was served with the Petition for Compulsory Discipline on September 24, 2021, at the Sheridan Federal Correctional Institution, 27072 Ballston Road, Sheridan, Oregon, by Candace Bernard, a Civil Deputy with the Yamhill County Sheriff's Department. A hearing on Petitioner's Petition for Compulsory Discipline is currently scheduled for October 29, 2021.
3. Petitioner requests a continuance in order to amend the current petition on file and allow time for proper service to Respondent.


**PRAYER**
