ORDER

On this day, the Board considered the Motion for Leave to File Out-Of-Time Brief, Exceed Word Limit & Appellant's TRAP 38.5(A)(4) Notice, filed by Appellant Lauren Ashley Harris in the above-numbered and captioned appeal.

The Board **GRANTS** Appellant's motion for leave to file her brief out of time and **ORDERS** that the Board will accept an appellant's brief under the conditions set forth below.

In its order dated March 12, 2025, Appellant was cautioned that Appellant's brief must not exceed the length limitation in BODA Internal Procedural Rule 4.05(d). The Board **DENIES** Appellant's motion for leave to exceed the word limit as set forth in BODA IPR 4.05(d) and **STRIKES** the Appellant's brief as filed on June 27, 2025, and the appendix to that brief as filed on June 30, 2025. Appellant is **ORDERED** to file a new brief that conforms with the BODA Internal Procedural Rules. Such brief shall be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 11, 2025. Any appendix accompanying such brief shall also be filed by 5:00 p.m. on July 11, 2025, but Appellant shall remain mindful that the appeal shall be decided on the appellate record as provided by BODA Internal Procedural Rule 4.02.

Failure to file a brief that conforms with the requirements of the BODA Internal Procedural Rules within the deadline established herein may be grounds for dismissal of this appeal. *See* BODA IPR 4.05(f), 4.09. Requests for extensions of time will not be granted absent extraordinary circumstances. Appellee's brief will be due thirty days from the date Appellant files a conforming brief.
