ORDER GRANTING CONTINUANCE

On this day, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the Motion for Continuance, filed by Respondent Mason William Herring on June 20, 2024, and the Supplemental Motion for Continuance, filed by Respondent on June 27, 2024, in the above-styled and numbered compulsory discipline case. Petitioner, the Commission for Lawyer Discipline, opposes the relief sought.

Having considered the motions and the Petitioner's response, the Board **GRANTS** Respondent's motions and **ORDERS** that the hearing on the Petition for Compulsory Discipline is reset to Friday, October 25, 2024, at 9:00 am in the courtroom of the Supreme Court of Texas, Austin, Texas.

The Board further **ORDERS** that the parties shall file additional briefing addressing the following issues:

1. Was Respondent convicted of an "Intentional Crime" and "Serious Crime" as those terms are defined by Texas Rule of Disciplinary Procedure 1.06, as interpreted by the Supreme Court of Texas?
2. Was Respondent's sentence "fully probated" as the term is used in Texas Rule of Disciplinary Procedure 8.06, such that the Board has discretion to suspend

Respondent's license to practice law during the remainder of Respondent's criminal probation?

Petitioner's brief addressing the above issues shall be filed on or before July 25, 2024.

Respondent's brief shall be filed on or before August 22, 2024.

Any relief requested and not expressly granted is denied. Further continuance requests from Respondent shall be disfavored.
