FIRST AMENDED ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE ON PETITION FOR RECIPROCAL DISCIPLINE AND HEARING NOTICE

Pursuant to Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure ("TRDP") Part IX, the Commission for Lawyer Discipline, Petitioner, filed a First Amended Petition for Reciprocal Discipline against Respondent Robert Theodore Hume on September 7, 2021. The First Amended Petition states that on or about December 1, 2020, the District of Columbia Office of Disciplinary Counsel issued a letter containing an Informal Admonition in the matter styled *In re Robert T. Hume, Esquire*, D.C. Bar Membership No. 114132, Disciplinary Docket No. 2018-D346. A true and correct copy of the First Amended Petition for Reciprocal Discipline, which includes the Informal Admonition letter, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as if set forth in full.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** that Respondent Robert Theodore Hume shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this First Amended Order to Show Cause on Petition for Reciprocal Discipline, show cause why the imposition of identical discipline, to the extent practicable, in Texas by the Board of Disciplinary Appeals pursuant to Texas Rule of Disciplinary Procedure 9.02, would be unwarranted.
