ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

On this day came on to be heard the Appellant, Rosalind A. Kelly's Appellant's First Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Appellant's Brief and Unopposed Motion to Withdraw and/or Dismiss Appeal. After reviewing the papers filed in the matter, the Board finds that the Appellant filed the notice of appeal on October 30, 2017. The clerk's record and the reporter's record from the evidentiary hearing were due to be filed on or before December 19, 2017. The Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas ("CDC") filed the clerk's record with the Board on December 18, 2017. The Appellant moved for an extension of time to file the reporter's record and it was granted. The reporter's record was due on February 20, 2018 and was filed on February 20, 2018. The Appellant's brief was not timely filed.

An Order to Show Cause was issued on April 5, 2018 giving the Appellant thirty (30) days to show cause why the appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. The Appellant responded and requested an extension of time to file her brief but stated that she was not intending to file a brief and requested that the appeal be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this appeal is hereby DISMISSED with prejudice to refile.
