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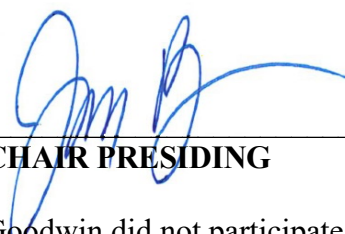

**ORDER DENYING APPELLEE'S
MOTION TO DISMISS FOR WANT OF JURISDICTION**

On this day, the Board considered the Motion to Dismiss for Want of Jurisdiction filed by the Appellee, the Commission for Lawyer Discipline, in the above-numbered and captioned evidentiary appeal. After considering the record and the pleadings filed by the parties, the Board **DENIES** Appellee's Motion to Dismiss for Want of Jurisdiction.

The Board finds that the reporter's record has not been filed in this case. On February 25, 2026, the Board, through its Executive Director and General Counsel, notified Respondent that the reporter's record was late and requested that it be filed within thirty (30) days. Having still received no reporter's record, the Board **ORDERS** that the reporter's record be filed within thirty (30) days after the date of this order. Appellant's failure to make arrangements for the filing of the reporter's record by that deadline shall subject this appeal to dismissal for want of prosecution. *See* BODA INTERNAL PROCEDURAL RULES 4.03(a)-(b), 4.09(b).
