COMES NOW, Petitioner, the Commission for Lawyer Discipline (the "Commission"), and pursuant to Texas Rule of Civil Procedure 162, files this notice of nonsuit of its claims in this attorney disciplinary action.

This action was predicated on a Judgment of Conviction by Jury in Cause No. CR21-002; styled *The State of Texas v. Donald Edward Little*, in the 51st District Court, Irion County, Texas, where Respondent was found guilty of Misapplication of Fiduciary Property – a third-degree felony. Respondent agreed to the entry of an Agreed Interlocutory Order of Suspension in this matter on January 26, 2023, while he appealed his conviction. After the conclusion of his appeal, Respondent passed away on November 4, 2023.
