## **ORDER**

On April 8, 2024, Appellant Pejman Maadani filed his signed Hearing Acknowledgement Form in the above-captioned and numbered appeal from a Judgment of Active Suspension issued August 14, 2023, by Evidentiary Panel 4-3 of the District 4 Grievance Committee. On that Form, Respondent indicated that he "waive[s his] opportunity to participate in oral argument and consent[s] to have the matter decided on the record and briefs." In its brief on the merits, the Commission for Lawyer Discipline, Appellee, stated its belief that "oral argument is unnecessary in this case as the facts and legal arguments are adequately presented in the briefs and the record, and the Board's decisional process would not be significantly aided by oral argument."

Because the parties consent to having this evidentiary appeal heard on the record and briefs, without oral argument, the Board **ORDERS** that this case has been removed from the April 26, 2024, hearing docket and set for submission on the pleadings on April 26, 2024.
