ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO REVERSE AND REMAND

On this day, the Board considered the Joint Motion to Reverse and Remand filed in the above-numbered and captioned evidentiary appeal. Citing a lack of effective service of the original disciplinary petition, the parties agree that the default Judgment of Partially Probated Suspension issued by Evidentiary Panel 4-5 of State Bar District 4 Grievance Committee on April 29, 2025, should be set aside and the matter remanded to the Evidentiary Panel for further evidentiary proceedings.

Without hearing oral argument or considering the merits, the Board **GRANTS** the Joint Motion and **ORDERS** that the Judgment of Partially Probated Suspension, issued April 29, 2025, is **REVERSED** and the matter is **REMANDED** to Evidentiary Panel 4-5 of State Bar District 4 Grievance Committee for further evidentiary proceedings.

Appellant Summer Aja McElroy's Motion for Extension of Time to File Notice of Appeal is **DISMISSED** as moot.
