## JUDGMENT AFFIRMING DEFAULT JUDGMENT OF DISBARMENT

On June 16, 2005, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the appeal of Nazmudin Keshwani, M.D. from the Default Judgment of Disbarment signed June 4, 2004 by the evidentiary panel of the District 4C8 grievance committee of the State Bar of Texas in Cause No. H0060315903 et al. Respondent attorney Joseph A. Mohr and the Commission for Lawyer Discipline of the State Bar of Texas did not participate in the appeal. Appellant Keshwani appealed only the failure of the judgment to award him restitution.

The Board finds that the evidentiary panel did not err in declining to award Appellant restitution and that the judgment should therefore be **AFFIRMED**.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that the Default Judgment of Disbarment signed June 4, 2004, in Cause No. H0060315903 *et al.*, is **AFFIRMED** in all respects.
