**ORDER AFFIRMING JUDGMENT**

On June 16, 2005, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the appeal of Booker T. Morris III from the Judgment of Partially Probated Suspension signed May 26, 2004, by the District 4D12 evidentiary panel of the State Bar of Texas district grievance committee in Cause No. H0110024663. Neither party having requested oral argument, the Board considered the appeal on submission of the record and the briefs.

The Board finds that there was substantial evidence to support the findings of misconduct, and that the disciplinary sanction imposed was not an abuse of discretion. Therefore, the Board has determined that the judgment should be in all respects **AFFIRMED**.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that the Judgment of Fully Probated Suspension signed May 26, 2004, in Case No. H0110024663, is **AFFIRMED** in all respects.
