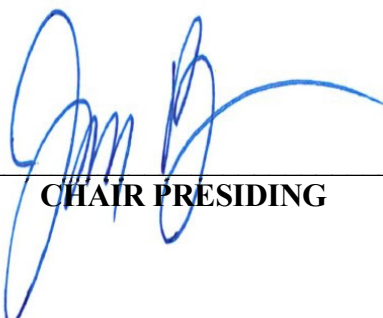
ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Appellant Michael McLane Nelson Jr. filed a notice of appeal on March 3, 2026. The clerk of the District 9-3 Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas filed the Clerk's Record on March 20, 2026. In accordance with BODA's Internal Procedural Rule 4.03(a), the reporter's record was due to be filed on March 30, 2026.

On April 20, 2026, the Board sent Appellant a letter stating that the reporter's record was late and requesting that Appellant that the reporter's record be filed within thirty (30) days. The letter notified Appellant that failure to make arrangements for the filing of the reporter's record on time may result in the Board dismissing the appeal.

Having received no reporter's record and no request for an extension of time to file the reporter's record, the Board **ORDERS** that Appellant Michael McLane Nelson Jr., within ten (10) days from the date of this order, **RESPOND AND SHOW CAUSE** why the appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. *See* BODA INTERNAL PROCEDURAL RULES 4.03(a), 4.09.
