## ORDER GRANTING CONTINUANCE AND ESTABLISHING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

On this day, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the Agreed Motion for Continuance and to Establish Briefing Schedule, filed by Respondent Earl S. Nesbitt in the above-captioned reciprocal discipline case. Petitioner, the Commission for Lawyer Discipline, is not opposed and agrees to the relief sought.

## The Board **ORDERS** as follows:
