ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Appellant Dominique Ross Nwajei filed a notice of appeal on October 7, 2025. The clerk of the District 4-2 Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas filed the Clerk’s Record on December 9, 2025, Supplemental Clerk’s Record on January 7, 2026, and Second Supplemental Clerk’s Record on February 11, 2026. In accordance with BODA’s Internal Procedural Rule 4.03(a), the reporter’s record was due to be filed on December 13, 2025.

On December 16, 2025, the Board sent Appellant a letter stating that the reporter’s record was late and requesting that Appellant that the reporter’s record be filed within thirty (30) days. The letter notified Appellant that failure to make arrangements for the filing of the reporter’s record on time may result in the Board dismissing the appeal.

Having received no reporter’s record and no request for an extension of time to file the reporter’s record, the Board **ORDERS** that Appellant Dominique Ross Nwajei, within ten (10) days from the date of this order, **RESPOND AND SHOW CAUSE** why the appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. *See* BODA INTERNAL PROCEDURAL RULES 4.03(a), 4.09.
