
JUDGMENT AFFIRMING PARTIALLY PROBATED SUSPENSION

On January 20, 2006 the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the appeal by Respondent below Bartholomew C. Okonkwo, State Bar Card No. 15241600 from the Judgment of Partially Probated Suspension in SBOT Cause No. H0040315337 signed February 16, 2005, by the evidentiary panel of the State Bar of Texas District 4B3 grievance committee. After reviewing the record and the briefs filed by the parties, the Board finds that the judgment should be affirmed. Appellant failed to file the reporter's record from the evidentiary hearing on appeal, despite having been given a reasonable opportunity to cure pursuant to Texas Rules of Appellate Procedure 37.3(c). In the absence of a reporter's record, the appellate court will presume that the reporter's record contains all matters supporting the trial court's judgment. *Favolaro v. Commission for Lawyer Discipline*, 994 S.W.2d 815, 820 (Tex. App.—Dallas, no pet.).

All Appellant's points of error are overruled.

It is therefore **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** that the Judgment of Partially Probated Suspension signed February 16, 2005 in Cause No. H0040315337 is in all respects **AFFIRMED**.
