ORDER DENYING AMENDED MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

On this day, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the Amended and Unopposed Motion for Continuance of Hearing Set for July 31, 2026, filed by Respondent, Richard Anthony Patti, in the above-captioned compulsory disciplinary case. Respondent seeks a continuance of at least 90 days to allow the 262nd Judicial District Court and appointed special counsel an opportunity to “consider pending and forthcoming motions to modify and terminate the order for deferred adjudication and dismiss the underlying charge.” However, Respondent has provided no information about any such motions. The district court’s records reflect that Respondent’s Motion to Modify Conditions of Community Supervision, pending before the district court and set for hearing on July 29, 2026, seeks relief only as to the amount of restitution Respondent has been ordered to pay as a condition of community supervision.

Having considered Respondent’s motion and the arguments therein, the Board **ORDERS** that Respondent’s Amended Motion for Continuance is **DENIED**. The hearing remains set for July 31, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. in the courtroom of the Supreme Court of Texas.
