ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

On this day, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the Motion for Continuance and Proposed Briefing Schedule filed by Petitioner, the Commission for Lawyer Discipline, on March 28, 2025. Respondent Kenneth M. Plaisance indicated via email to the Board of Disciplinary Appeals that he is unopposed to the relief sought by Petitioner.

The Board **ORDERS** as follows:

- 1. The Motion for Continuance is **GRANTED**, and the hearing on the petition for reciprocal discipline is reset for Friday, July 25, 2025, at 9:00 am in the courtroom of the Supreme Court of Texas, Austin, Texas.
- 2. The Agreed Motion to Establish Briefing Schedule is **GRANTED AS MODIFIED:**
 - a. Pursuant to the order of the Board issued March 31, 2025, Respondent's motions seeking immediate dismissal of this reciprocal discipline case, filed March 19 and 21, 2025, were denied, though Respondent may assert the arguments and introduce the evidence contained therein at the hearing on July 25, 2025. Therefore, no further responsive briefing from Respondent as to those motions is necessary. However, Respondent may submit prehearing briefing on any anticipated issues per the schedule established

herein.

- Petitioner's briefing as to Respondent's answer, defenses, and any other responsive pleadings or dispositive motions shall be filed no later than June 2, 2025.
- c. Respondent's reply shall be filed no later than June 13, 2025.
- d. The final deadline for briefing, responses, and replies by Petitioner is June
 20, 2025.
- e. The final deadline for briefing, responses, and replies by Respondent is June 27, 2025.
- f. Motions to extend any of these deadlines shall be disfavored.

Further continuance requests shall be disfavored.

Any other relief not expressly granted in this order is denied.
