**JUDGMENT AFFIRMING EVIDENTIARY JUDGMENT OF DISBARMENT**

On October 23, 2014, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals heard argument on the merits in Appellant Craig F. Sandling’s appeal from a Judgment of Disbarment signed July 1, 2013, by the Evidentiary Panel 9-3 of the District 9 Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas. Appellant appeared in person pro se, and the Commission for Lawyer Discipline of the State Bar of Texas appeared through Assistant Disciplinary Counsel with the Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel.

After considering the record and the briefs of the parties and hearing argument, the Board finds that the Judgment of Disbarment should be, in all respect, affirmed.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** that the Judgment of Disbarment signed by the Evidentiary Panel 9-3 in SBOT Cause A0041214451 on July 1, 2013 be, and hereby is, in all respects **AFFIRMED**.

It is further **ORDERED** that Appellant’s Motion for Leave to Amend Appellant’s Brief, Alternatively or Additionally for Rebriefing is **DENIED**.
