**ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION**

On this day came on to be heard the Board of Disciplinary Appeals' own motion to dismiss the appeal filed by Alfredo A. Soza for want of prosecution. After reviewing the papers filed in the matter, the Board finds that the Appellant filed the notice of appeal of the judgment of partially probated suspension signed on November 20, 2012 by the District 15-4 evidentiary panel in case nos. S0011226607 and S0041227014 on November 20, 2012. The clerk's record and the reporter's record from the evidentiary hearing were due to be filed on or before March 20, 2013. The Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas ("CDC") filed the clerk's record on March 20, 2013. On March 29, 2013, the Appellant filed an incomplete reporter's record. On June 4, 2013 the Appellant filed a complete reporter's record. The Appellant's brief was due on or before July 5, 2013. The appellant's brief has not been filed, and Appellant has not requested an extension of time to file his brief.

On August 19, 2013 this Board issued its Order to Show Cause wherein the Appellant was ordered to respond and show cause as to why the cause should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. Appellant did not respond or file a brief or request an extension of time to do so.
