CORRECTED ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION

The Order Dismissing Appeal for Want of Prosecution signed by the Board of Disciplinary Appeals on March 27, 2015 reflected an incorrect State Bar of Texas card number for the appellant, Stephen W. Taliaferro. It is State Bar of Texas card number 19621475 and this order corrects that error.

On March 27, 2015 came on to be heard the Board of Disciplinary Appeals' own motion to dismiss the appeal filed by Stephen W. Taliaferro for want of prosecution. After reviewing the papers filed in the matter, the Board finds that the Appellant filed the notice of appeal of the judgment of disbarment signed on September 25, 2014 by the Evidentiary Panel No. 15-3 for the State Bar of Texas in case no. 201307287 on October 27, 2014. The clerk's record and the reporter's record from the evidentiary hearing were due to be filed on or before November 26, 2014. The Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas ("CDC") filed the clerk's record with the Board on November 26, 2014. The reporter's record was not filed. The Appellant's brief was due on December 26, 2014. The Appellant's brief has not been filed, and Appellant has not requested an extension of time to file his brief.

An Order Show Cause was issued on February 19, 2015 giving the Appellant 30 days to show cause why the appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. The Appellant did not respond, did not file his brief nor did he ask for an extension to file his brief.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this appeal is hereby **DISMISSED** for want of prosecution with prejudice to refile.
