**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE**

This reciprocal discipline case is currently set for hearing on the merits on January 30, 2015 as first setting. Respondent John Holman Weigel was served with the Board's Show Cause Order with hearing notice and the Petition for Reciprocal Discipline on December 30, 2015. Respondent has not answered the petition for reciprocal discipline.
