ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Appellant Kenneth Shane Walker filed a notice of appeal on August 20, 2021. The clerk's record and the reporter's record from the evidentiary hearing were due to be filed on or before November 18, 2021. The clerk of the District 6 Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas filed the clerk's record with the Board on November 18, 2021. No reporter's record or appellant's brief has been filed. On March 4, 2022, the Board sent Appellant Walker a letter stating that the reporter's record was late, requesting that the reporter's record be filed within 30 days, and notifying Appellant that failure to file the reporter's record may result in the Board dismissing the appeal, affirming the judgment, disregarding late-filed materials, or applying presumptions against the Appellant.

Having received no reporter's record or appellant's brief, the Board **ORDERS** that Appellant Kenneth Shane Walker shall, within 30 days from the date of receipt of this order, **RESPOND AND SHOW CAUSE** why the appeals should not be dismissed for want of prosecution.
