ORDER DISMISSING MOTION FOR ENTRY
OF JUDGMENT OF DISBARMENT AS MOOT

On July 26, 2012, this Board signed an Agreed Interlocutory Judgment of Suspension suspending Respondent William George Gammon III from the practice of law pending the conclusion of his appeal of his criminal conviction. On June 6, 2013, the Commission for Lawyer Discipline filed a Motion for Entry of Final Judgment of Disbarment including the mandate of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit stating that the appeal of Gammon's criminal conviction was final and that the conviction had been affirmed. On October 14, 2013, the Supreme Court of Texas accepted Gammon's resignation in lieu of discipline, making this compulsory proceeding moot.

Therefore, the Board hereby **DISMISSES** the Motion for Entry of Final Judgment of Disbarment as **MOOT**.
