AGREED ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR REVOCATION OF PROBATION AND ACTIVELY SUSPENDING RESPONDENT FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW

On this day, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the Petition for Revocation of Probation against Respondent, Hollie Vesla Greene, filed by the Commission for Lawyer Discipline of the State Bar of Texas pursuant to Texas Rule of Disciplinary Procedure 2.23.

Petitioner, Commission for Lawyer Discipline, appeared through Laura Bayouth Popps, Deputy Counsel for Administration, and Respondent, Hollie Vesla Greene, appeared as indicated by their respective signatures below and announced that they agree to the findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders set forth below.

The Commission for Lawyer Discipline seeks to revoke Respondent's probation of suspension from the practice of law imposed under the Agreed Judgment of Partially Probated Suspension in case number D0100733381, D0020834124. The Evidentiary Panel of the District 7A Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas signed the Agreed Judgment of Partially Probated Suspension on October 20, 2008.

The Judgment contained certain terms and conditions of probation and ordered that Respondent would be actively suspended from the practice of law for a period of one (1) year, without credit for any term of probation served prior to revocation, in the event that Respondent

failed to comply with those terms and conditions. The sanction imposed by the Judgment began

December 1, 2008, and ends November 30, 2009.

The Board of Disciplinary Appeals, having reviewed the file and in consideration of the

agreement of the parties, is of the opinion that Petitioner is entitled to entry of the following

findings and orders:

The Board finds that Respondent has materially violated the terms and conditions of

probation and should be suspended for the full term of the suspension as originally assessed

without credit for any probationary period served.

It is therefore ORDERED that the Petition for Revocation of Probation be GRANTED,

and that Respondent, Hollie Vesla Greene, State Bar No. 24006564, be, and hereby is, actively

SUSPENDED from the practice of law in the State of Texas for a period of one (1) year effective

immediately on the date this judgment is signed.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Respondent, Hollie Vesla

Greene, during said suspension is hereby prohibited, effective immediately, from practicing law

in Texas, holding herself out as an attorney at law, performing any legal service for others,

accepting any fee directly or indirectly for legal services, appearing as counsel or in any

representative capacity in any proceeding in any Texas court or before any Texas administrative

body, or holding herself out to others or using her name, in any manner, in conjunction with the

words "attorney," "counselor," or "lawyer."

It is further ORDERED that Respondent, Hollie Vesla Greene, shall notify in writing, no

later than thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, each and every justice of the peace, judge.

magistrate, and chief justice of each and every court in which Respondent, Hollie Vesla Greene,

has any legal matter pending, if any, of her suspension, of the style and cause number of the

pending matter(s), and of the name, address, and telephone number of the client(s) Respondent is

representing in that court. Respondent is also ORDERED to mail copies of all such notifications

to the Statewide Compliance Monitor, Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel, State Bar of

Texas, P.O. Box 12487, Capitol Station, Austin, Texas 78711.

It is further ORDERED that Respondent, Hollie Vesla Greene, shall immediately notify

each of her current clients, if any, in writing, of her suspension. In addition to such notification,

Respondent is ORDERED to return all files, papers, unearned fees paid in advance, and all other

monies and properties which are in her possession but which belong to current or former clients,

if any, to those respective clients or former clients within thirty (30) days after the date of this

Order. Respondent is further ORDERED to file with the Statewide Compliance Monitor, Office

of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel, State Bar of Texas, P.O. Box 12487, Capitol Station, Austin,

Texas 78711, within the same thirty (30) days, an affidavit stating either (a) that all current

clients have been notified of her suspension and that all files, papers, unearned fees paid in

advance, and all other monies and properties belonging to clients and former clients have been

returned as ordered herein or (b) that Respondent has no current clients, files, or papers, and that

any unearned fees paid in advance or other monies or properties belonging to clients have

previously been returned to the appropriate client. If Respondent is unable to return any file,

papers, money or other property to any client or former client, Respondent's affidavit shall state

with particularity the efforts made by Respondent with respect to each particular client and the

cause of her inability to return to said client any file, paper, money or other property.

Respondent is also ORDERED to mail copies of all notification letters to clients to the Statewide

Compliance Monitor, Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel, State Bar of Texas, P.O. Box

12487, Capitol Station, Austin, Texas 78711.
